

**"The aim of the Heritage Arabian Racing Club is to help ensure, through racing, the long-term future of the purebred Arabian horse, where original, classic characteristics, in the broadest terms, are valued along with the breed hallmarks of athletic ability, soundness and versatility."**

HARC horses which can take part in our races must comply with the following definition.

**" In order to preserve the original, classic characteristics of the purebred Arabian horse, it has been agreed that a HARC (Heritage Arabian Racing Club) horse is any purebred Arabian registered in any WAHO accepted studbook, but it must not contain the blood of the following stallions in any generation of its pedigree. Stallions excluded are Amer, Baroud III, Burning Sand, Dragon, St Laurent and Tiwaiq".**

**"Other horses may from time to time be added if considered necessary after formal agreement by the Club Management Committee and agreement at an AGM. Such horses will remain pending until they are approved."**
